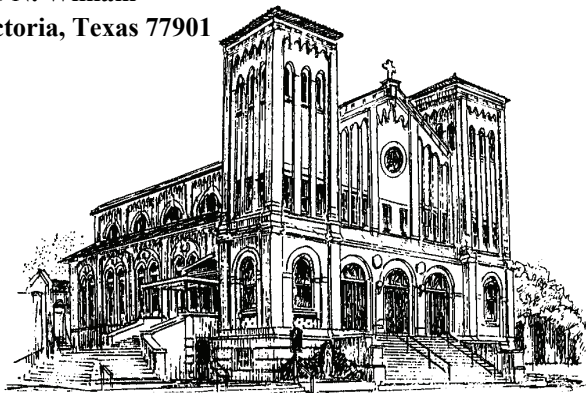

The Cathedral of Our Lady of Victory will be offering an **Adult Confirmation Course** this **April - May**.

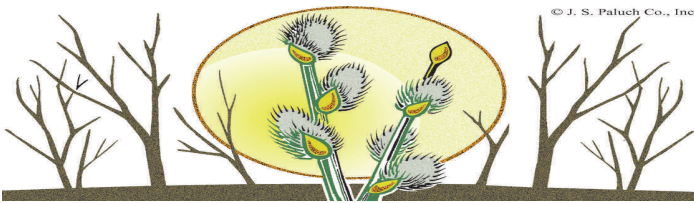
This is a class for adult Catholics in the Victoria deanery who have received religious education, either in a Catholic school or through CCD classes, but need the final preparation for the Sacrament of
