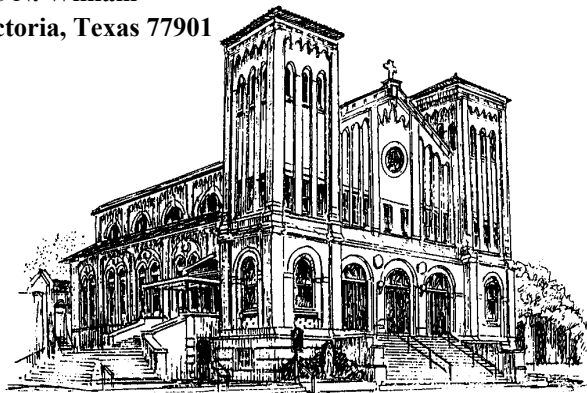

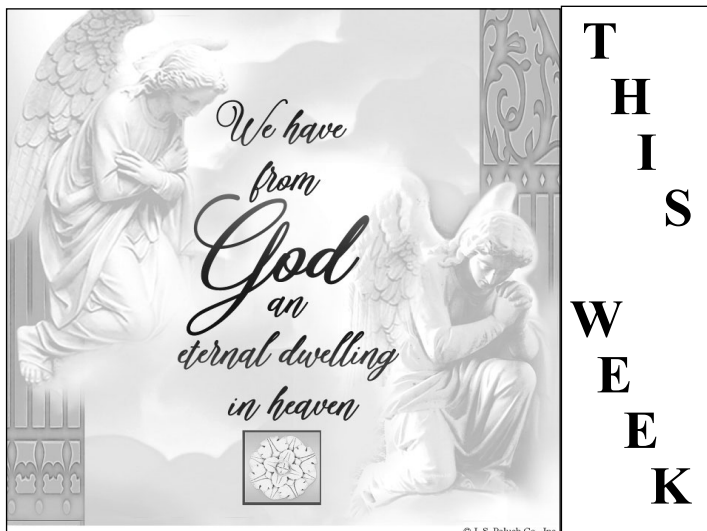

This feast is now commemorated on every First Friday of the month. The Feast of the Sacred Heart is one of the most popular in the Catholic Church. It is celebrated in the spring on a different date each year (19 days after Pentecost Sunday). This year, the Solemnity falls on June 8th. Please mark your calendar.
